A jury trial on all claims and defenses was held in this matter commencing on June 21, 2022. On July 1, 2022, the jury rendered its verdicts by way of two special verdict forms. Pursuant to the jury's verdicts and Rules 54 and 58 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure, the

Court now enters final judgment fully resolving all claims and defenses of the Plaintiffs and Defendants as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. Defendant Shanice C. Burch is liable for negligence, and Defendants Lube Management Corp. and PartsCo, L.C. d/b/a Mighty Auto Parts are liable for negligent employment, and judgment is entered against Defendants and in favor of Plaintiff Tim Symes in the amount of \$3,642,202.64, comprised of the following:

Incurred economic damages	\$113,625.64
Future economic damages	\$2,300,000.00
Noneconomic damages	\$1,200,000.00
Prejudgment interest	\$ 28,577.00

2. Defendants Shanice C. Burch, Lube Management Corp. and PartsCo, L.C. d/b/a Mighty Auto Parts are liable for loss of consortium and judgment is entered against Defendants and in favor of Plaintiff Amy Symes in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).
3. Punitive damages are awarded against Defendant Lube Management Corp. and in favor of Tim Symes in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).
4. Plaintiffs are awarded post-judgment interest accruing at the statutory rate until this Judgment is paid in full.
5. Plaintiffs are awarded their reasonable costs incurred in this case in accordance with Rule 54 of the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure.
